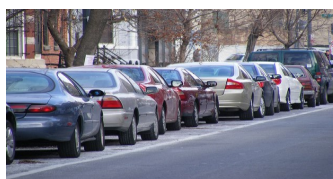

Children at Risk

Parking, particularly when children are dropped off and picked up, is a on going problem. I have written to parents and carers on many occasions about this issue.

We have a minority of parents/carers who are causing a dangerous situation by parking on yellow zig zags, performing dangerous manoeuvres on the congested roads around school or just generally not taking care.

On some days it is a miracle that an accident does not occur, either through this behaviour or children crossing the road unsupervised.



Your children have been proactive in trying to make the roads around school a safer place.

They have run road safety campaigns and have worked with enforcement officers. We have had enforcement weeks and regularly put out warning boards. This does not seem to be enough.

I met with one of our Wibsey Councillors, Cllr Joanne Sharpe, with the suggestion that we have double yellow lines down one side of the road to at least eradicate the single

lane and dangerous parking so near to the school building.

I am now asking that you email all our ward councillors with a request that something is done about this as a matter of urgency.
