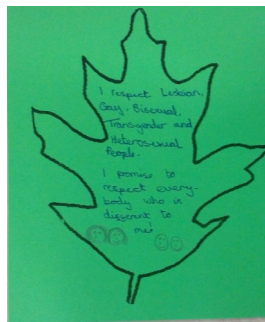
Diversity Role Models
