Attendance

I have been reviewing attendance figures with the Senior Management and Leadership Team, also helped by the office staff. Whilst we can see some great attendance for a large number of our children and some big improvements for others, we quite simply have a group where attendance is not good enough. The school has set

the quite ambitious target of each child having no attendance of less than 97%. The national average is 96.1% and we currently stand at 95.1%. This means that with all of the issues thrown into the mix that can lead to time off, we do worse than other schools nationally.

So what do we do about this? There will be a tighter focus from the office

to you about reported absences. There will be an increased requirement for medical proof for longer term or recurrent medical conditions, and where absence falls below 96% we will need to meet to look at the reasons. Great attendance will be rewarded as we work together, but hold each other to account.
