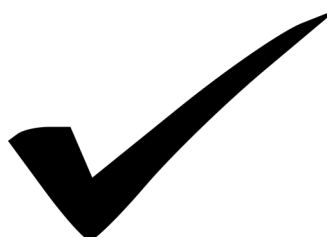

I am delighted to say that following our recent inspection we have been judged as a school that continues to be Good.

Inspectors reviewed a range of lessons, held meetings with staff, looked at children's work as well as talking to the children and some parents. They got a really good view across the work we are doing. The inspectors agreed with our own self evaluation as a school—that we are most definitely a Good school,



having initially been given this judgement in our inspection of November 2012. This is against a set of criteria that is tougher than in 2012 and expects more of us and of your children. I am particularly pleased that safeguarding was judged effective with inspectors saying "There is a culture of safeguarding at the school" and that

"Governors know the school well".
