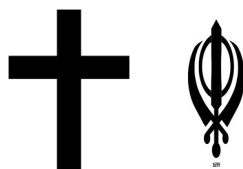

Family Holidays

Almost all holiday requests are turned down, in line with guidance, unless there are extreme and pressing exceptional circumstances.

I would point out that the Governing Body at Wibsey Primary School have thought long and hard about the pressures families face in taking holidays—particularly about the costs you face. I would remind you that the next holiday has been extended by a week

(using up all training days) to give you a chance to book cheaper breaks that fall outside regular school holidays. This year the dates are 27th May, returning 12th June 2017. Next year we will be closed 18th May to 4th June 2018. This allows a full 2 weeks where breaks are substantially cheaper. When I checked this week a family week in Spain is £502pp for the traditional half term week offered by all schools—£298pp in our extra holiday week.
