


# Extended Project 'Where I Live' Week 2

# Day 1 – DT - Architecture

Think about the buildings that are already in Bradford.



Your task is to create a building or a structure (such as a bridge or statue) to **inspire** the residents in Bradford.

You need to plan and design this in your exercise books.

Let's have a look at some other pieces of architecture elsewhere so you can take ideas from it.



This is the Gateshead Millennium Bridge. It crosses the River Tyne and connects the City of Newcastle to Gateshead, which is a place in the North East of England. It is famous across the country as an impressive structure that tilts to allow boats to pass beneath it. Why not search for a video of the bridge moving?



This is the London Eye. It is in Waterloo, an area of London. It overlooks the River Thames. There are pods that people can go in and view the skyscape of London. It is famous across the country as an tourist attraction and landmark.



This is the Angel of the North. It is in Gateshead in the North East of England. It was made in 1998 and designed by Anthony Gormley. It is placed on an old coal mine near the A1 and the train line into Newcastle. Anthony Gormley said he picked the angel as it gives a 'sense of embrace'. It is famous across the country as a landmark of the North of England.
