Monday	<p>Practice writing the trick word <b>he</b></p> <p>Remember to use your whooshes for each letter.</p>	<p>Choose an amount of coins up to 10. Whilst your child is not looking, drop the coins 1 by one into a piggy bank or tin (something that will make a noise) and ask your child to count them. Did they count them correctly? Can they count it in their head? Can they count it if the coins are dropped quicker?</p> <p>Challenge: Drop all of the coins at the same time. Can your child estimate (guess) how many you dropped and then check by counting?</p>	<p>Recap on the phoneme "ay".</p> <p>Watch <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ROKNNvuGpEo">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ROKNNvuGpEo</a> up to 2 mins 45.
