Update to all families from Mr Cooper – 26th June

In my continued efforts to making sure you know what I know, this is my Friday round up and information sharing letter - plus the letter below from George and Mildred to share with your children.

Year 6. We have offered places for Y6 leavers to come in and contribute to their online leaving video for slots in the week commencing 13th July. These will be confirmed with families. Please encourage your children to work on their clips for the leavers' video.

Other Year groups. We will probably have space for a final group of children to be offered pre summer places. Details will follow on Monday.

Lunches. Now that we have more children in we will move back to the paid or free school meal options. This will mean there will no longer be online ordering. If your child is entitled to a free school meal they will have the range of options to choose from on a daily basis. If you pay for your child's meal, then please do this via Parent Pay. Again there will be the range of sandwich and other options from the last few weeks. You may now send your child with a packed lunch, but this must be in a disposable bag so that all wrappings and containers can be binned at the end of lunchtimes.

Summer. School will be closed for the whole of the 6 week break. To ensure we can be ready for September we will be closing to attending pupils on **Friday 17th July, not Monday 20th**. This is a change to the printed holiday cards.

September. Other than wanting all children in school in September we have had no other Government guidance. They have promised this information next week and myself and the Senior Team will try and share plans with you asap. Again – I would ignore the press speculation. I will share the facts as they apply to WPS.
