Day 1 – Sound Effects

Many audio books use sound effects to **enhance** the retelling of the story.

Using the book you are reading at the moment, or one you have read recently, pick one chapter and think about the sound effects you could use. Make a script of this in your books.

Challenge – Can you think about how you can change the **pitch** of sounds made from your instrument? Think about how a guitar works to help you with this.

Day 4 – PE



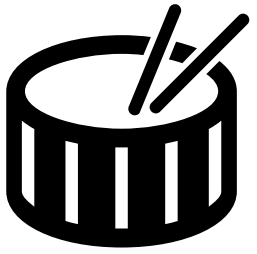
