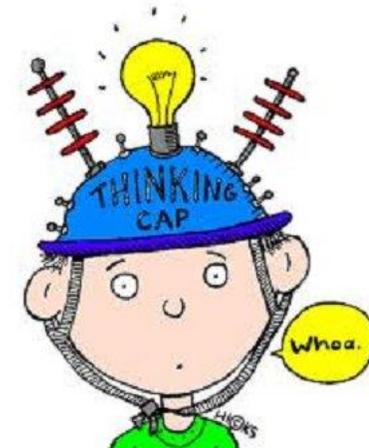

An equilateral triangle has three angles the same and three sides the same length.




An isosceles triangle has two angles the same and two sides the same length.


