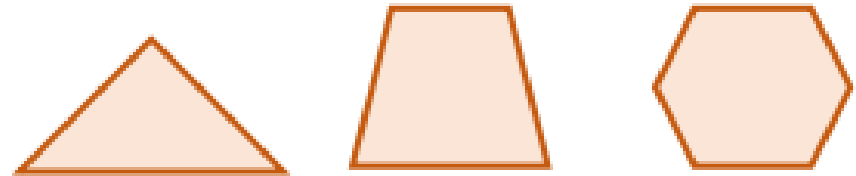


Mark 3 sets of parallel lines and 3 sets of perpendicular lines in this flag.

What is the same and what is different about these shapes?



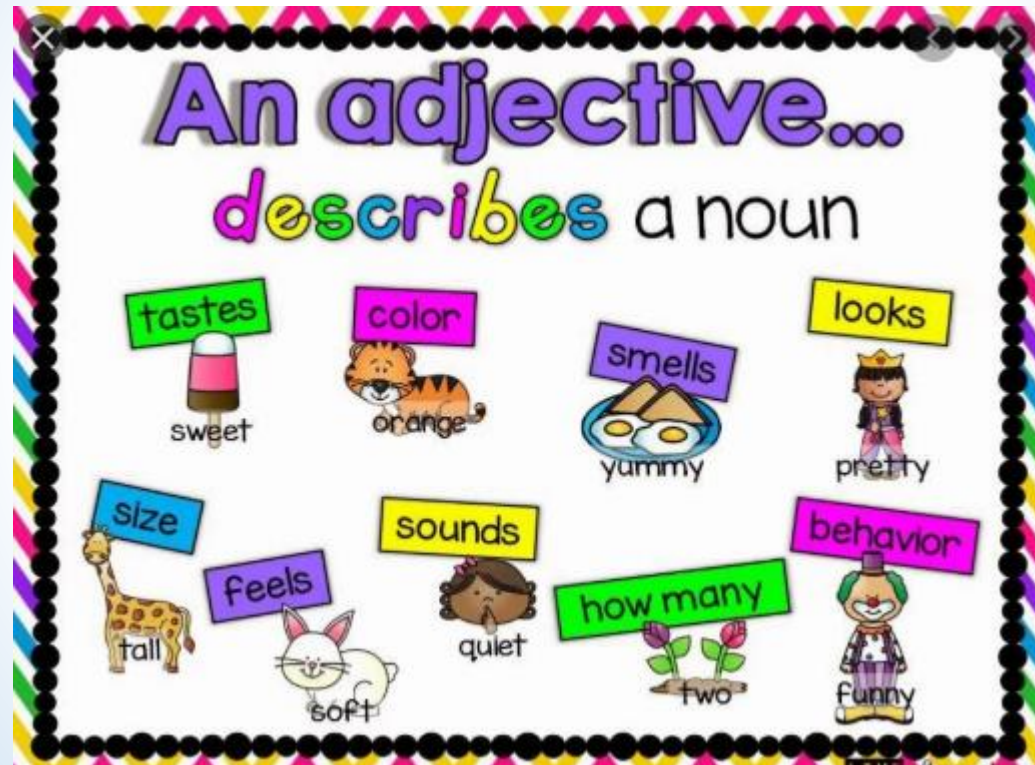
