Here are some of the things that you can be doing to get ready for Nursery, even if you've been before.

- Talk to your adult about how you'll say good-bye to them and who will be coming to collect you from Nursery each day.
- Practise recognising your own name.
- Ask an adult to write your name in your school uniform, coat and shoes so that they are easy to find if you take them off at Nursery.
- Find a small bag to fit on your Nursery coat hook and put in some spare clothes, just in case you get wet.

I'm going to be very busy during the summer; I'll be planning all kinds of exciting activities, so that everyone gets to know each other quickly and makes new friends. Remember to bring a coat to Nursery each day because there's going to be lots happening outside.
