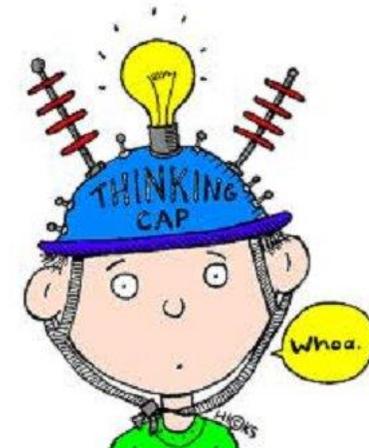

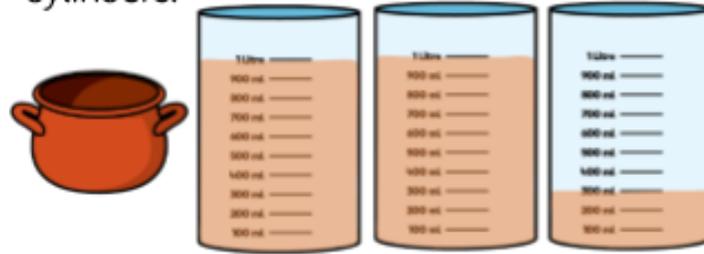

$16-7=9$

[Turning his back to the class Mr Chalk carries on writing on the blackboard]

$5 \times 2 = 10$

Neil: [Whispering in Carl's ear] Watching the caretaker empty the bins was more interesting. And I don't like numbers anyway!

$18-5=13$

Carl: Shhhhhh! You'll get us both into trouble.

$1+12=13$

Mr Chalk: Now who's talking? [Pointing his finger] Dempsey, is that you? I might have known. Each of you is as bad as the other. Mr Grimm's office...NOW!

$8-4=4$

Carl: But...but...

$3 \times 3 = 9$

Mr Chalk: [Opening the door] Not one more word.

$1+12=13$

Neil: Sorry, Carl.

Carl: You will be!

$1+12=13$

$10-4=6$

$3 \times 4 = 12$

$4+5=9$

$3-3=0$

$5+6=11$

$2 \times 6 = 12$

$12+1=13$

$6-4=2$

$8+5=13$

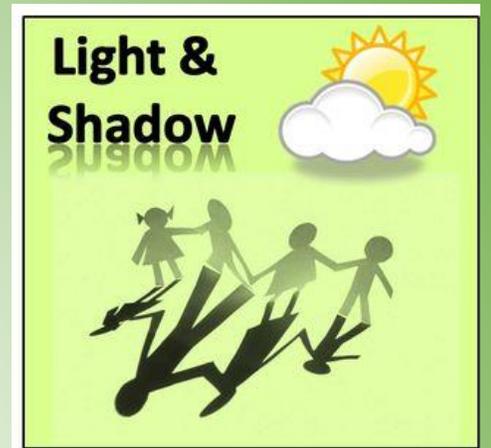
Activity - Story Writing - Lesson 1
