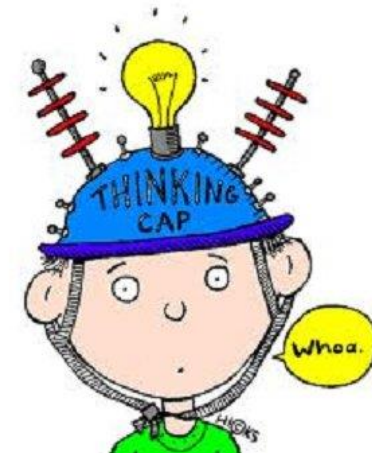

Is Tommy correct?

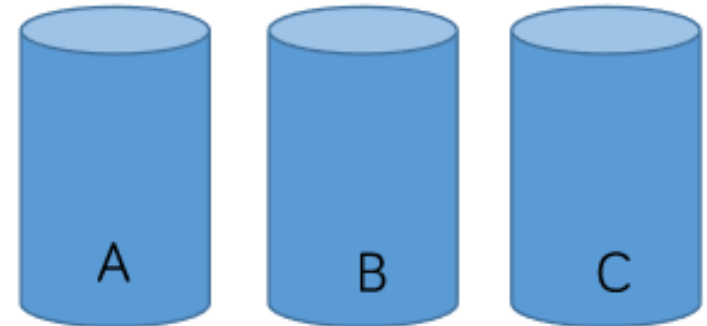
If not, how much juice will be left in jug 2?
