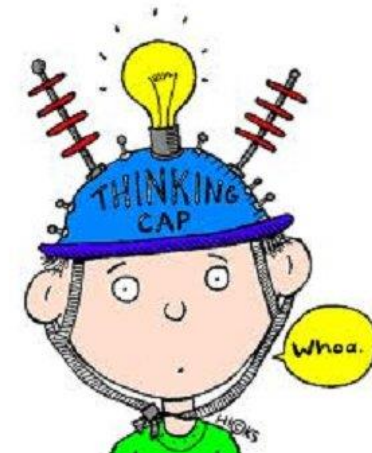

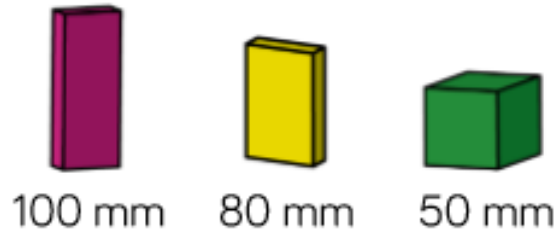

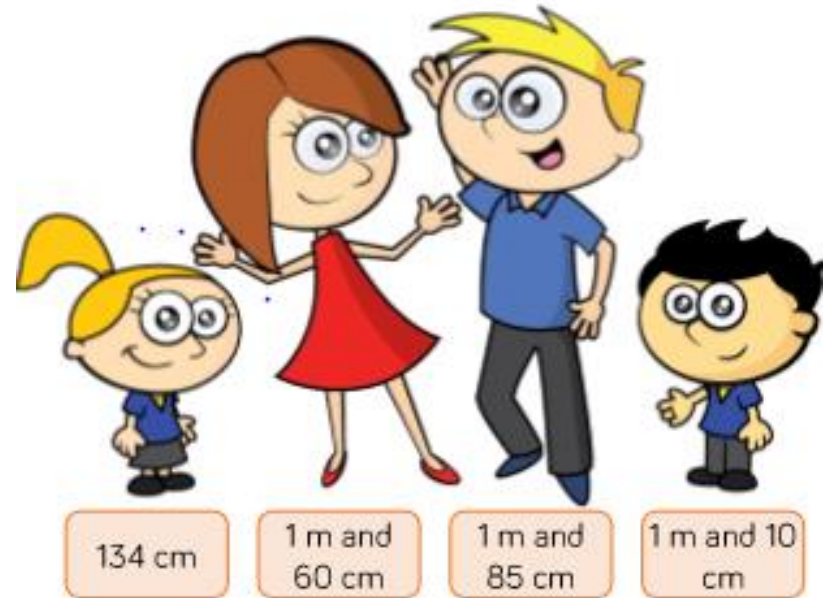


Eva is building a tower using these blocks.

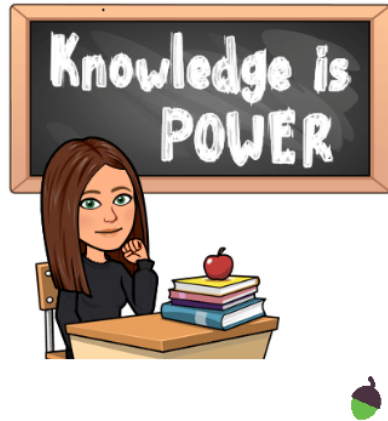

Key Features of a Story

- Adjectives/expanded noun phrases
- Fronted adverbial phrases
- Adverbs
- Conjunctions
 - Co-ordinating (and, but, yet, so...)
 - Subordinating (because, that, when...)
- Inverted commas
- Full range of punctuation from previous year groups (question marks, exclamation marks, commas in a list, apostrophes)
