Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to announce that we have received funding from the government as part of their National Breakfast Programme. This will enable us to set up a Bagel Bar each morning. This will be based at every entrance to school. Should children want, they will be able to get a bagel to eat while they walk to and line up in the playground. We hope that all children will take us up on the offer of a bagel before school, which will help them maintain their energy and concentration whilst learning.

The Bagel Bar will be staffed by Wibsey Staff and they will be prepared in the school kitchen and be placed into paper bags to ensure they comply with food hygiene regulations. Within breakfast club, bagels and cereals will be added to the selection as part of this scheme so that the children get an added choice.

Allergies: Unfortunately, we cannot cater for allergies as the bagels are delivered to us. If you know your child cannot have one please let a staff member know. Allergens are wheat and dairy.
