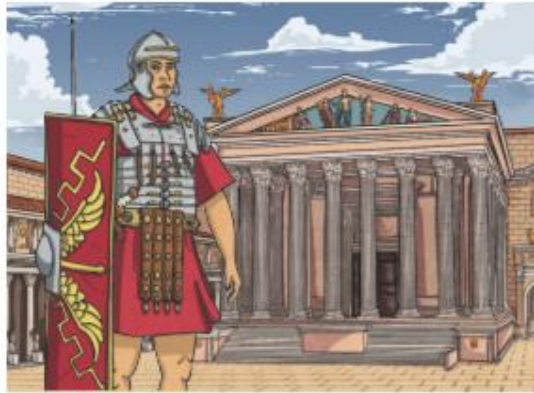
**AD 43**

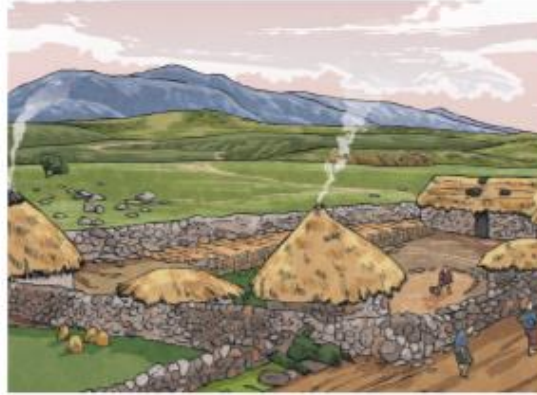

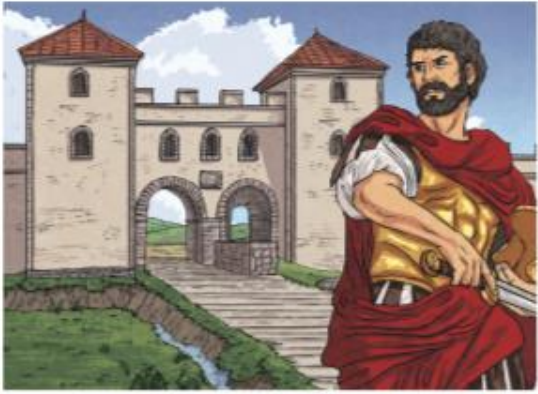
**AD 1016**
