Spanish Day



At Wibsey Primary School we are very proud of the exciting curriculum that we offer to our children.

Primary schools have to teach a modern foreign language and we have chosen Spanish for our children. They reach a high standard, and I am amazed at their oral Spanish skills.

Next Thursday we will be having a Spanish day and children across school will be learning more about Spain and its culture – as well as having opportunity to further practice their spoken Spanish.
