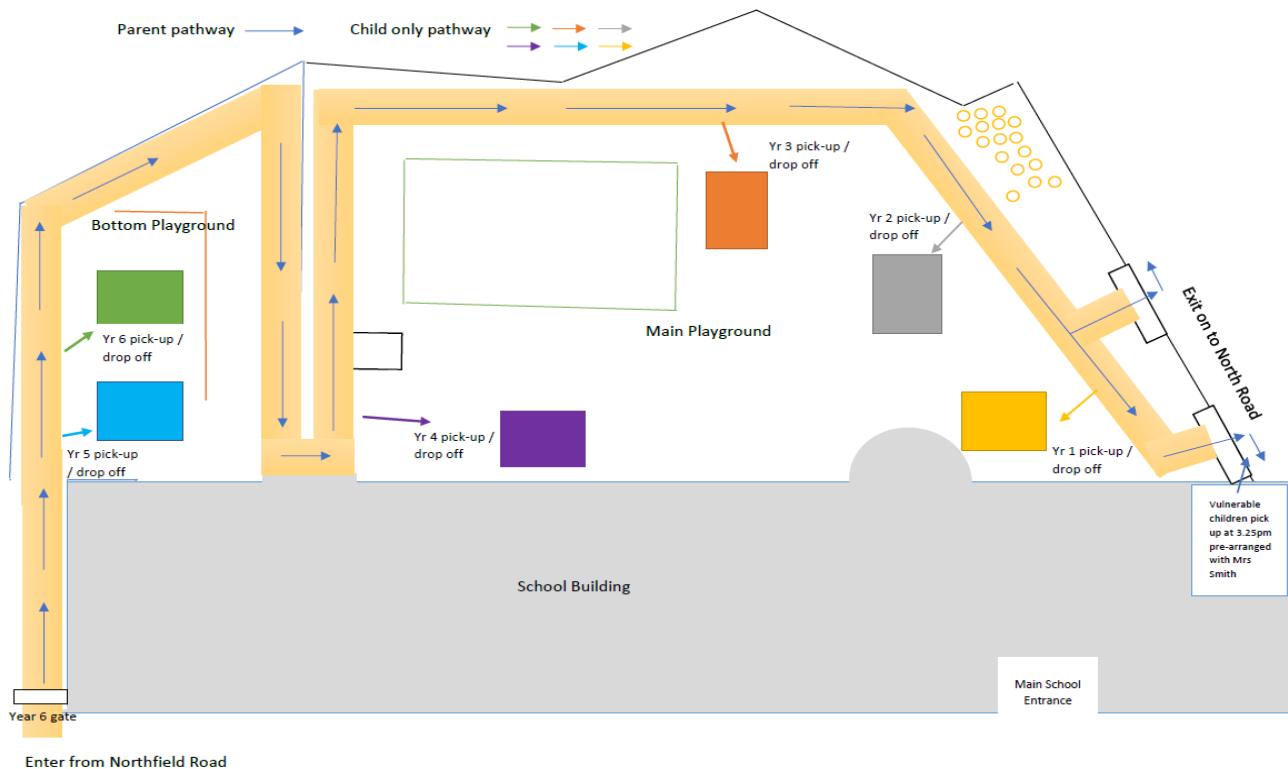
For this week you will need to bring your child to line up with their new teacher (Current R-Y5, Nursery will be staying as they are). Attached below is an outline of the playground which shows the area where the teacher will be to receive your child. You will also need to collect your child from this area also following the one-way system.

For children currently in Reception, (new Year 1) this will be a big change for them so please talk them through it. Staff will already have shown them the route into the playground and where they will meet their Year 1 teacher.

Children currently in Year 6/New Year 7 will be based across in the Reception building for this week. They have lots of exciting activities planned. They will enter the one-way system in the Foundation area and the map for that is attached below. Please remind them that the Nursery children are still attending in their building therefore to be extra careful of little ones when walking around that area.
