National Coal Mining Museum Visit

Dear Parent/Carer,

As an integral part of Year 5's work in Geography, it is planned to take the children to visit the National Coal Mining Museum on the following dates:

Friday 15th October 2021 – 5.3 (Mr Richards' class)
Wednesday 20th October 2021 – 5.2 (Mr Hudson's class)
Friday 22nd October 2021 – 5.1 (Mrs Noble's class)

The visit will provide an opportunity to study first-hand how coal was mined, its uses and how it has impacted the lives of the workers and the landscape around the colliery. During our visit, we will take a guided underground tour of the coal face, participate in a pit village workshop as well as visiting the museum.

On the day of their visit, we ask that your child attends school for the slightly earlier time of **08:30**. This will provide us with ample time to fully explore the centre. We shall return before the usual end of the school day at 15:30, therefore no alternative arrangements for the collection of your child need to be made.

Your child should attend in uniform, bring a warm, waterproof coat and have appropriate shoes on (trainers/pumps rather than school shoes). Your child will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink in a carrier bag so it can be disposed of on site (no glass bottles please). If your child is entitled to a free school meal, this will be provided by school. No sports drinks, sweets, money or cameras should be brought.

There is **no charge for this visit** as transport, insurance and admission to the centre has been covered by the school.
