Lateness

Last week over 19
hours of learning was
lost due to lateness.
Every minute late is a
minute lost of learning.

Classes follow a set
timetable so children
who are late will often
be missing parts of the
same lesson every day.
For example Year 1
have Phonics at the
start of every day and
Year 6 have Maths.

Persistent lateness will
adversely affect your
child's attainment in that
subject. Ten minutes
late every day is 50
minutes of Phonics or
Maths missed every
week—equivalent to
one whole lesson!
