We are hearing a lot at the moment about the cost of living crisis that many people are facing. At school we are budgeting for a 54% rise in energy costs—which is likely to cost us at least an extra £30,000. If you haven't—don't forget to take and submit your own meter readings today as the old prices finished yesterday.

We will do what we can to support our community. School Parliament—your children—have agreed that we continue to

have our local foodbank as our on-going key charity and that events will be focussed on supporting them. In addition we are going to run our “good as new” uniform stall in the summer and autumn terms. If you have any uniform that is in good condition and of no use to you then please bag it and pop it into the school office so we can begin to sort this. I will also review our school visits to make sure as many use the minibuses as possible—bringing down the costs as we

subsidise these. If you are entitled to Free School Meals then please make sure you are registered as this sometimes opens up the door to other support.
