We are having various stalls and are raising funds to go towards the subsidies we provide to each of the classes visits, and to pay for the Christmas presents we give to each child.

As an incentive to make this a whole school Christmas Fair, we are holding a **non-uniform day** in return for contributions on **Thursday 9th November**. Contributions can be big or small – be as creative as you like with the collections as detailed below for your child's year group.

Reception/Nursery – anything chocolate
eg bar of chocolate, chocolate biscuits, chocolate cake.

Year 1 – anything in a bottle
eg wine, pop, bubble bath, juice, aftershave.

Year 2 – anything containing the colour red
eg nail varnish, candles, a jar containing sweets but decorated in red.

Year 3 – anything containing the colour silver
eg photo frame, Christmas decorations, silver gift bag containing an suitable item.

Year 4 – anything containing the colour gold
eg pen set, Nescafe Gold, gold chocolate coins, a gift wrapped in gold paper.

Year 5 and 6 – item for the general tombola
anything new or unused please.
