PE uniform should only be worn on PE days and should be

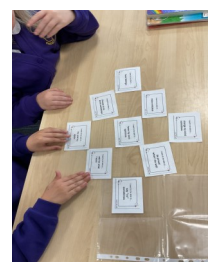
unbranded items—plain black joggers and tops, and plain black trainers please.
