## Final Summer Half Term

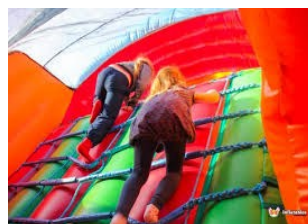
