



Transition Letter – Year 6

Dear Parent/Carer,

Our Year 6 children have been absolutely amazing this year. Their hard work, resilience and enthusiasm have made us incredibly proud and we are delighted to see them move into the next stage of their journey. As they prepare for secondary school, we are launching our very own 'Transition College'.

From Monday 13th July to Monday 20th July, children participate in a series of organised activities in school or as part of a residential. Different children will take part in different activities. These sessions are designed to build confidence, independence and the key skills they will need as they move into a secondary environment. During this week, we will also be holding a Pupil Takeover Day, giving the children a chance to step into new roles and responsibilities.

Throughout Transition Week, our aim is to support the children in becoming “secondary ready” by giving them opportunities to experience what life in a secondary setting feels like—moving between activities, working with different adults and developing greater independence.

Outside of the residential arrangements, children should arrive at school at the usual time, entering through the Year 6 entrance (opposite the car park). The children will be dismissed at the end of the day from here too.

To help the children navigate Transition College, they will be given a colour-coded lanyard indicating their group and timetable. Children not attending Dobroyd will receive their lanyard on Monday. Children attending Dobroyd will receive theirs on Thursday.

We are incredibly excited to run this project and look forward to supporting the children as they take those important steps into secondary school.
