Please see below for the transition week arrangements for Monday 13th July:

On Monday morning, all children should line up in the main playground in their **new** class lines.

Each class has a cone which identifies the class number on it.

Year 1 - line up in the top playground outside the ramp nearest the top gate.

Year 2 - line up in the middle playground to the left of the conservatory entrance.

Year 3 - line up in the middle playground to the right of the conservatory entrance.

Year 4 - line up in the middle playground to the right of the Year 3 classes.

Year 5 - line up in the bottom playground.

Year 6 - line up in the MUGA in the bottom playground.

Teachers, support staff, pastoral staff and the senior team will be out on Monday morning with class lists to help you to find the right class line.

Children will continue to be picked up and dropped off from these lines for the remainder of the week and into September.

We hope everyone has a happy, smooth and successful transition into their new classes.
